- The Agile manifesto
- The philosophy and the principles of AgilePM
- The AgilePM lifecycle (the processes)
- The AgilePM documents (the products) that support the project governance
- Roles and responsibilities within an Agile project
- Key practices: prioritization and Timeboxing (sprints)
- Planning and controlling the project throughout the Lifecycle
- Other Agile practices: facilitated workshops, modelling and iterative development
- Delivering projects on time: combining MoSCoW prioritization and Timeboxing
- Requirements and user stories
- The effective use of the Products
- Estimating techniques: how and when? "Estimate effort and derive duration"
- Project planning through the lifecycle
- Quality assurance in an Agile project
- Risk management
- How to tailor AgilePM to your needs?
